After spending his entire career in private practice at Sutherland Asbill & Brennan, *Richard L. Robbins* launched his own firm, *RobbinsLaw LLC*, with three former Sutherland lawyers, on May 1. The firm will handle litigation and regulatory work, including business and real estate litigation as well as environmental, employee covenant and trade secrets work.

Robbins, who co-headed the complex business litigation team at Sutherland, said via e-mail that he'd always wanted his own firm for the "flexibility to do plaintiffs' cases and to pursue a different business model and fee arrangements.
